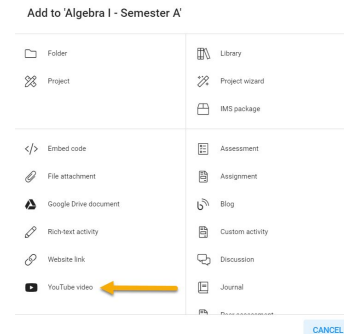
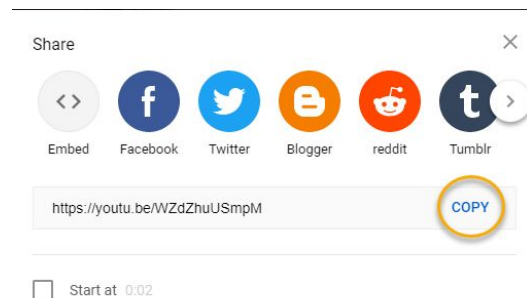


Adding a YouTube Video into an Instructional Unit

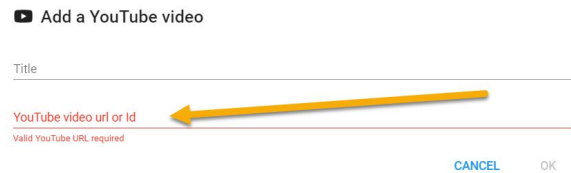
- YouTube videos can be easily added to an Instructional Unit.
- Navigate to the course that you would like to insert a video into and select “Editor”
- At the bottom of the course syllabus, select “Add Activity”, this will bring up the menu to select what type of activity to add in, select “YouTube Video”.



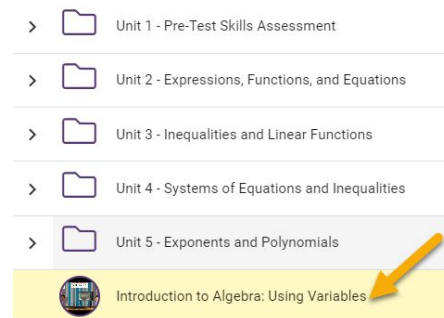
- Navigate to Youtube.com and locate the video that should be added into the unit.
- Click on the “Share” icon. This will bring up a URL link with options for sharing on social media sites.
- Select “Copy” to copy the URL of the video to be placed in your unit.



- Navigate back to your BrightThinker platform and copy the URL onto the line specified.
- Provide your video a title, then hit “Ok”.



- The video will now appear in the unit’s syllabus and activity list.



Adding a YouTube Video into an Instructional Unit

- Move the video to be placed in the Unit by dragging and dropping, or, by clicking on the triple dot menu and selecting “Move Up” or “Move Down”
